- Research methodology and fieldwork techniques
- Economic, political, and religion-anthropology

PAPER-II Indian Anthropology (250 Marks)

- Tribal demographics and distribution in India
- Problems faced by Indian tribes: land alienation, poverty, displacement
- Scheduled Tribes and their welfare schemes
- Caste system, social change, village studies
- Tribal movements and development administration
- Constitutional safeguards and governance

Build a conceptual base with Class XI–XII Biology & Sociology.



Understand diagrams and definitions

Especially useful in Paper I for physical anthropology.



Paper I is more static

Emphasize clarity in concepts and evolutionary details.



Paper II requires case-based knowledge

Use contemporary tribal issues and government reports.



Interlink theory with current tribal issues

Example: FRA 2006, PESA Act, displacement due to mining projects.



Use flowcharts, maps, and diagrams

They fetch extra marks in answers.



Refer to Standard Reports

Like XAXA committee, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, NITI Aayog, etc.

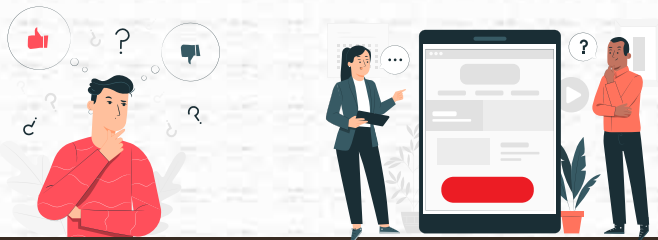
