## Target 250+ Essay and Ethics Crash Course

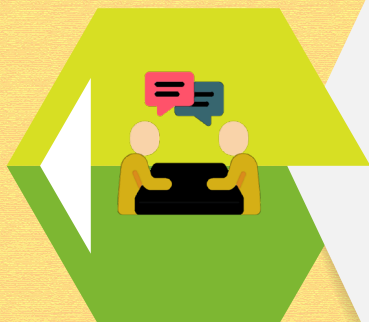
- Thematic classes on Essays

## Sectional Tests + Simulator Tests

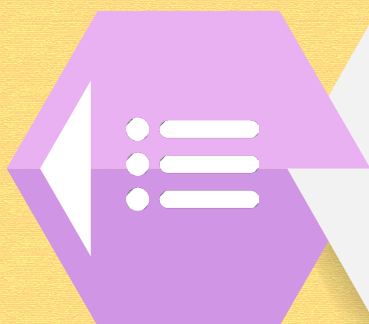
- 5 Tests on GS subjects + 1 Essay test

### **Mentorship**

- Mentor allocation based on student profiling (Number of mains given by students, academic strengths wrt mains, optional subject, etc based on such data suitable mentors will be allotted)
- UPSC CSE Interview-appeared/Rank Holders-Mentors to guide, handhold, and supervise your progress during the next 75 days.



### **Optional Tests & Discussions**

- 6 Fortnightly Tests (\*Note- Only the PSIR, Sociology, Anthropology, Public Administration, History, Geography optionals are provided)
- Coverage of 150+ Questions with model answers
- Discussion of tests by Faculty members
- Evaluation within 4-7 days
