

The Foundation Phase Live Foundation Program

The success in UPSC CSE depends on a solid foundation. During the next 18 months, you will be undergoing a rigorous process-driven foundation course, where you will be taught around 15+ subjects by our expert faculties.



Offline Classes

The essence of the GS foundation program is the foundation classes. StudylQ through our expert faculties will be conducting offline classes every week from Monday to Saturday - 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

Handouts

Before every class, you will be provided with class notes in the form of CRUX. After the classes, we will be providing the lecture / board PPTs and handwritten notes of that class.





Mentorship

During your entire 2-year journey, our mentors will track your progress and guide you through your academic journey. Your Mentor will act like a friend, philosopher and guide so that you can have a personalized help during the preparation journey.

Daily Quiz

To test your understanding, daily prelims questions (MCQs) will be provided based on the topic taught in the class. We will also be conducting Weekly prelims tests to ensure that you develop the required problem-solving skills.





Answer Writing Skills

A Weekly mains answer writing will be conducted throughout the program. In addition, a full-length Mains test will be conducted every 3 months to consolidate your answer writing skills.

Current Affairs Classes

Understanding current affairs adds context to your knowledge. Current Affairs will be covered on a weekly basis every Sunday. In addition to this, a monthly magazine will be provided every month to consolidate your knowledge.





CSAT Classes

To master the CSAT portion of the prelims syllabus, CSAT classes will be conducted by our expert faculties every alternative Sunday.

The Integrated Phase

During the integrated phase of five months, the whole syllabus of UPSC CSE will be covered in an holistic manner with the primary focus on mains. This phase will equip you with a consolidated

topic-wise knowledge base which will take your preparation to the next level.



Offline Theme Based Classes

Classes will be focussed on theme based learning outcomes. These themes will be extracted based on the current events and UPSC exam pattern.



Weekly Current Affairs Classes

These classes will cover important topics from the mains and prelims perspective. Topics will be based on the news cycle of the previous week. You will also get access to monthly magazine and weekly current affairs documents in soft copy format.



Brainstorming Pointers handouts

These advanced handouts will be provided to students to quickly revise the themes and gather to the point knowledge for writing precise answers.



Mentorship

During your course, your personal mentor will keep track of your preparation using advanced technological tools. Mentors will especially focus on incremental improvements in your answer writing along with solving your doubts related to your preparation.



Weekly Mains Test and evaluation

Mini Test of 10 questions will be conducted every week on themes which have been covered in that particular week. Answer writing practice will be supplemented by detailed discussions on tests which will help you cover the subject holistically.



Weekly Prelims Test

Half Length Prelims tests (50 questions) will be conducted every week on the topics which have been covered in the week. These tests will help you keep your prelims preparation on track.



CSAT classes

Towards the end of the integrated phase, you will be provided with CSAT classes from our expert faculties to help you master the CSAT portion.

- 4. Saturday Prelims and Mains test on themes covered throughout the week.

How to make best use of Advanced Course?

- 5. Practice Tests: Attempt the Weekly Prelims and Mains Test on Saturday.
- 6. Performance Evaluation: Have a 1:1 mentorship session with your personal mentor on the basis of your performance in the weekly tests.
- 7. Incremental improvement: Constantly strive to improve based on feedback from the mentor, evaluation of mains answers, and prelims score.

The Prelims Phase Success in Prelims

There are more than 9 lakh aspirants who fill the form for 10 thousand seats to write the mains. The success rate is \sim 1%. Given the competition, being in 1% doesn't just take you towards the mains but also builds your confidence to achieve the impossible.







The P2I (Prelims to Interview) GS Foundation batch 2025 will be a 2 year program till Jan 2026, when the commission will conduct the interviews. We will be handholding our students through the foundation, SIP, MRP and IGP phases.

Note

- The offline classes will be conducted at locations near Karol Bagh, Rajender Place, Old Rajender Nagar, and Patel Nagar. The Institute reserves the right to change/shift the location of the classroom as and when required.
- Students will be provided with video recordings of the classes, on web/app or any other platform reserved by the institute.

 Whether the classes will be recorded or LIVE will be based on the institute's discretion. In both cases, the students can note down their doubts and get them clarified by their mentors at the centres mentioned. Recorded videos of the class will be provided on the web/app to the students within 24 hours. These videos will be accessible till Jan 2026 and can be viewed any number of times.
- Students can be restricted from the classroom if found to be involved in any irregular or non-disciplinary activities with respect to the institute.
- The institute will not provide any vehicle parking, food or lodging facilities.
- The students will have to vacate the classrooms after the class ends so that students from other batches can be accommodated.
 Students can meet with the faculty and mentor within the premises of the institute.
- Offline classes will be conducted as per the timetable, however, the institute can change the timetable as and when required.
- The Institute reserves the right to conduct any test of prelims or mains in online or offline mode.
- Offline classes will be conducted as per the government regulations and the safety of the students.
- Classes can be extended for longer than the specified periods or two classes can also be conducted on the same day during the course.
- The Institute reserves the right to merge batches having the same timings as and when required.
- Additional Classes like Test discussions on Prelims & Mains or any other Special Sessions will be conducted by the institute, the
 timings of these additional classes can clash with the regular class timings. In any such case, it will be advisable to refer to the
 recorded discussion for these additional classes.
